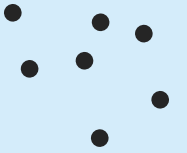

It all started with one “yes.” One step of obedience became 20 worship leaders, 10 nations represented, 8 languages, and a world of worship.

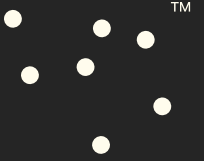
Gather Worship is a sound bigger than any one church or country—a reflection of the beauty and diversity of the global Church.
